

Notre Dame Academy Student/Parent Athletic Contract

The following constitutes the agreement between the student/athlete, their parents/guardians and the Notre Dame Academy Athletic Department. The covenants provided herein are in full effect until the conclusion of the current school year.

Section 1. Selection to Team

- 1.) It is understood that the selection to a sports team is at the discretion of its head coach according to the published selection criteria for the particular sport.
- 2.) Participation on a sports team or a conditioning class during a previous year does not constitute automatic selection for the following year.
- 3.) Students are required to try-out each year for every sport.

Section 2. Attendance

- 1.) It is understood that the athlete will attend every published practice unless she does not attend school.
- 2.) Individuals who miss a practice without the prior consent of the coach may be subject to forfeiture of participation in the next scheduled event.
- 3.) If a student does not attend school, she may not attend or participate in an athletic contest.
- 4.) In the event of prolonged illness or injury, the athlete must present a doctor's written consent for her participation in an athletic activity.
- 5.) Students who participate in another athletic competition outside of school will be required to give school-sanctioned competitions priority or face possible dismissal from the team.
- 6.) Students may not participate in two sports at the same time.

Section 3. Transportation

- 1.) School provided transportation will be available at all scheduled contests at the opposing school's site.
- 2.) Students are required to use school provided transportation at all times for contests at the opposing school's site unless by written consent between coach, athletic director and parent/guardian.
- 3.) Off-campus practice facilities are provided for the sports of cross country, soccer, track & field, swimming and softball. It is the responsibility of the student/athlete and the parent/guardian to provide transportation to and from these sites.

- 1.) Except for the sports of cross country, swimming and track, the school will provide uniforms for all team members.
- 2.) Uniforms are to be returned at the conclusion of the season in clean and "like new" condition. Any damage to the uniform must be presented to the coach prior to the end of the season.
- 3.) Warm-ups are provided for selected sports and will be retained by the school at the end of the sports season.
- 4.) In the event that a warm-up is damaged, misplaced or not returned on time, the athlete will be assessed a \$200. fee that will be attached to your tuition billing.
- 5.) Non-payment of the warm-up fee will prevent an athlete from taking semester and/or final exams.

Section 1. Selection to Team

- It is understood that the selection to a sports team is at the discretion of its head coach according to the published selection criteria for the particular sport.

Section 2. Attendance

- It is understood that the athlete will attend every published practice unless she does not attend school.

- If a student does not attend school, she may not attend or participate in an athletic contest.
- In the event of prolonged illness or injury, the athlete must present a doctor's written consent for her participation in an athletic activity.
- Students who participate in another athletic competition outside of school will be required to give school-sanctioned competitions priority or face possible dismissal from the team.
- Students may not participate in two sports at the same time.

Section 3. Transportation

- School provided transportation will be available at all scheduled contests at the opposing school's site.
- Students are required to use school provided transportation at all times for contests at the opposing school's site unless by written consent between coach, athletic director and parent/guardian.
- Off-campus practice facilities are provided for the sports of cross country, soccer, track & field, swimming and softball. It is the responsibility of the student/athlete and the parent/guardian to provide transportation to and from these sites.
- In consideration of Article 3 above, my/our daughter has my/our permission to participate in the following forms of alternate transportation to practices and games: (indicated on signed contract)

Section 4. Uniforms

- Except for the sports of cross country, swimming and track, the school will provide uniforms for all team members.
- Uniforms are to be returned at the conclusion of the season in clean and "like new" condition. Any damage to the uniform must be presented to the coach prior to the end of the season.
- Warm-ups are provided for selected sports and will be retained by the school at the end of the sports season.
- In the event that a warm-up is damaged, misplaced or not returned on time, the athlete will be assessed a \$200. fee that will be attached to your tuition billing.
- Non-payment of the warm-up fee will prevent an athlete from taking semester and/or final exams.

Section 5. Handbooks / Pledge
